- A. <u>Bombay Beach North Properties</u> The Board will act on closing out the procedures for accepting individual claims on Bombay North.
- B. <u>Maintenance of the Berm</u>. –The primary solution is for the District to develop a scope of work for the Berm Project. An alternate solution comes from the Imperial County Public Works whom has offered to research an option to fix the flood problem at 5th Street by putting in a drainage system that takes flood water via gravity flow from 5th Street to the sea. (Item initially introduced 11/19/2015) (Knight)
- C. Installing a sump pump at the corner of 5th and Isle of Palm to control flooding of 5the Street. Director Knight is working to obtain title to the sump hole property at the corner of 5th St and Isle of Palm. The Board will discuss the issues with contracting out to install a sump pump. The Board will be briefed on the legal impacts the Board must consider before hiring a contractor to install the pump.
- D. Street Lights The Board will hear on the progress of installing solar street lighting at Bombay Beach. (Item introduced February 15, 2018) (Ministry of Kordada)
- E. <u>Disposition of excess equipment</u> Discuss the disposition of the blue water pump that is owned by the District. (introduced January 2018, Hawkins). Item tabled December 20, 2018 while waiting for Flood Control to be resolved)
