The Board is coordinating to get a movement from Sacramento politicians to help the town with water pumps generators and emergency power units.

Earlier in the meeting the Board approved sending volunteer ERU staff to the Disaster conference to the conference in LA on September 27 and 28, 2023. The District recently received a grant from Berkshire Hathaway to offset cost to train ERU personnel in responding to local emergency situations, these are the funds that will pay for that

training.
